SUMMER SCHOLARS PROGRAM

One of the goals of the Baltimore County Bar Association's Diversity & Inclusion Committee is to ensure that law firms in Baltimore County have the most diverse and qualified applicant pools when they are considering their hiring needs. To achieve this goal, we are launching a new initiative called the "Summer Scholars" program, which is designed to place diverse applicants in summer internships with law firms in Baltimore County.

We are pleased to offer the following opportunities, with more likely to follow:

- Large regional firm seeking a 1L student for the firm's Towson and Baltimore offices – \$1,150/week.
- Two family law firms seeking a 1L, 2L or 3L student for the firm's Towson office – compensation and hours per week to be determined.
- Multi-practice firm seeking a 1L, 2L or 3L student for the firm's Towson office – \$20/hour, 10-20 hours per week.
- Multi-practice firm seeking a 1L, 2L or 3L student for the firm's Towson office – compensation to be determined based on experience, 40 hours per week.
- Multi-practice firm seeking a 1L, 2L or 3L student for the firm's Towson office – compensation and hours per week to be determined.

Interviews will occur in March. The committee expects to communicate its decisions in early April. The starting and ending dates will vary by firm.
